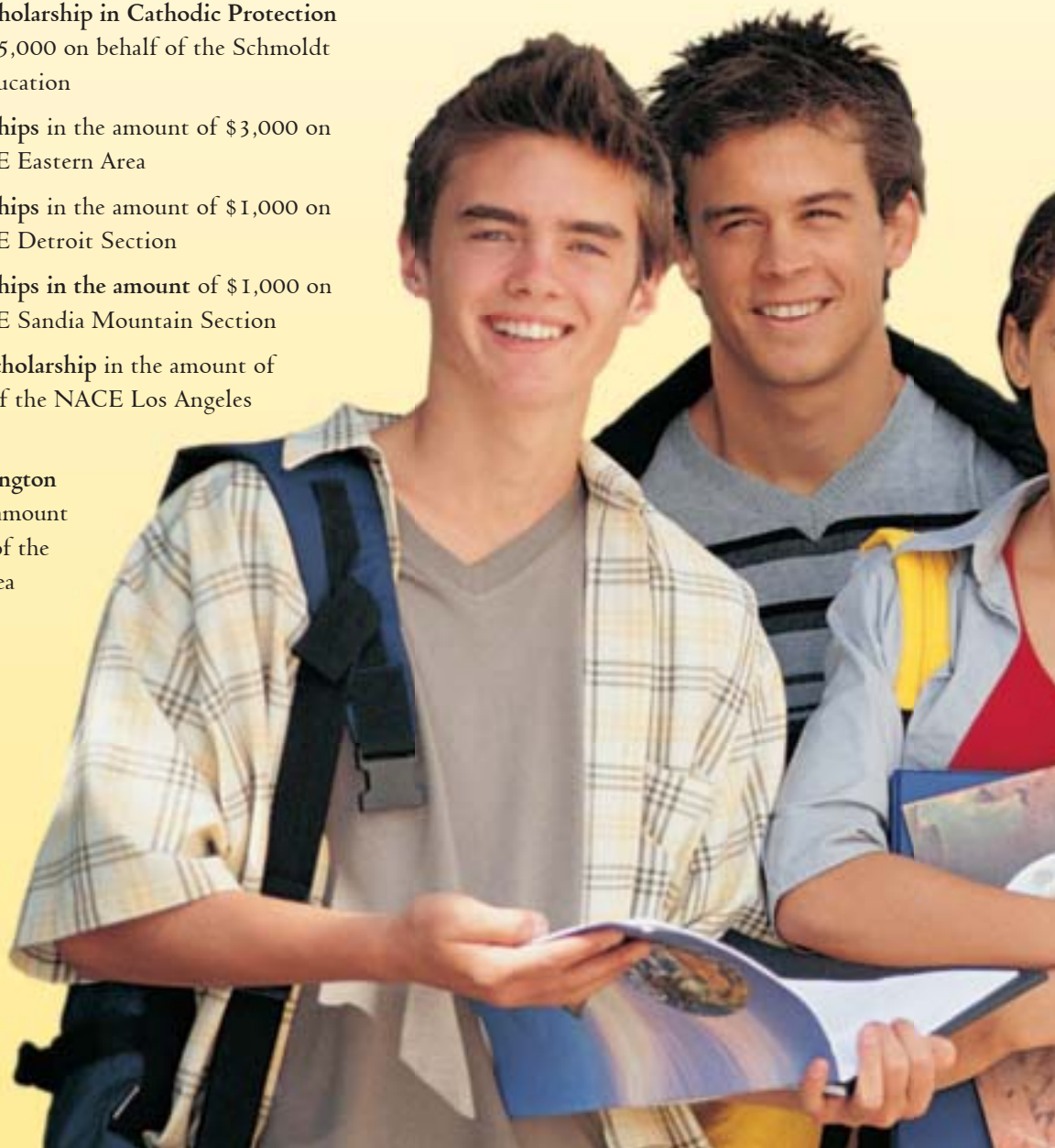
2008 NACE Foundation Scholarships/Awards
